### PLEASE KEEP THIS CARD HANDY Preparing for an Emergency

The following is a short checklist of the things you should be thinking about now, in case there is a possibility of an emergency – keep this list handy:

### Preparing for an emergency

- 1. Keep all family / friends' home and work phone numbers with you. Select someone living away to be your contact point. If anything happens, contact them.
- 2. Ensure your mains electrical, gas and water valves / switches are well marked and you can turn them on and off.
- 3. Get a member of the family on a first aid course.

### If an emergency strikes

- 4. Listen to local radio. Follow the advice of the emergency services.
- 5. Check for immediate dangers like smoke, water, unsafe buildings.
- 6. Assist vulnerable people near you.
- 7. Give first aid and get help.
- 8. Prepare to evacuate yourself, family, vulnerable neighbours and pets. If you have time and it is safe to do so, take your emergency bag.
- 9. Follow your personal contact plan (see point one).

# If you are evacuated and you have time

- 10. Turn off all services like electricity, water and gas.
- 11. Drain the water off if you can.
- 12. Pack an emergency bag with bottled water, radio and torch with spare batteries, your medication and first aid kit.
- 13. Pack what you would need for your own/family and pets' use for up to two days, including warm clothing, duvets and blankets, good waterproof boots, food and cash.
- 14. Bring cards, musical instruments, or small games for keeping children (and adults) amused.
- 15. Bring your pets, but anticipate that they may be kept elsewhere.
- 16. Lock the house up.
